Group of employees: research.

Discipline: architecture and urban planning.

Number of positions: one.

Planned employment : temporary contract from 1.04.2023 until 31.12.2026

Competition requirements:

The successful candidate will fill the requirements explicated of the PSWIN *Higher Education Law* (Law Journal 2022r., item 574), and will have the following:

1. possession of a doctoral degree in architecture awarded not more than 7 years before the year of employment in the project and the degree was not awarded by the entity where the post is to be filled
2. specialization in knowledge of Medieval Nubia;
3. outstanding experience in 3D modelling;
4. outstanding experience in documenting Medieval Nubian churches;
5. at least 5 years' experience in research work in Africa in the field of urbanism and architecture of ancient cities;





Key responsibilities include:

1. preparation of architectural documentation of churches researched in the project;
2. preparation of a three-dimensional reconstruction of the churches (both inside and outside);
3. providing architectural analyses of the churches;
4. presenting and disseminating the project's results;
5. carrying out tasks assigned by the Principal Investigator of the project, connected with the realisation of the project.

Required documents:

2. scientific curriculum with information on research achievements, organizational achievements and list of publications;

5. statement on getting acquainted with and accepting the rules for job applications in competitions for academic positions at the University of Warsaw.

The results of the competition will be announced by 15.03.2023. It is the first stage of the employment process for academic teachers set down in the UW Statute; a positive result is essential to proceed further. The candidates will be informed about the results of selection procedure by e-mail.
