### INTRODUCTION

The International Summer School, the School on *Augmented Archaeology. Archaeological research projects and modern science* is focused on learning how to conduct interdisciplinary archaeological field research following the standards of modern digital archaeology. Today's archaeological field research should adopt a new, expanded definition, assuming the cooperation of different disciplines - photogrammetry, geoinformatics, geology, surveying, geography, history of arts or conservation. The main aim of the School is to train young researchers in managing archaeological expeditions, funding them and what is crucial to properly define archaeological research questions and methodology.

The school is expected to lead to contacts with internationally recognised experts from leading archaeological institutions, promote Polish archaeological achievements in the Mediterranean and support the preservation of antique Cypriot heritage.

### DICTIONARY

AuAr 2023 – an acronym for International Summer School *Augmented Archaeology. Archaeological research projects and modern science*;

ISS – an acronym for International Summer School;

Polish Centre of Mediterranean Archaeology, University of Warsaw – the organiser;

Young research employees - According to Polish law, a young scientist is a person engaged in scientific activity who, 1) is a doctoral student or academic teacher - and does not have a doctoral degree, or 2) holds a doctoral degree,



from the awarding of which no more than 7 years have passed, and is employed in a University or Research Institute.

## GENERAL PROVISIONS

### § 1

1. The School on Augmented Archaeology. Archaeological research projects and modern science (AuAr 2023) is a project under the 'Excellence Initiative - Research University (IDUB) programme, financed by the University of Warsaw.
2. The main organiser of AuAR 2023 is the Polish Centre of Mediterranean Archaeology, University of Warsaw, supported by the Institute of Archaeology, Faculty of History of Jagiellonian University and Archaeological Institute, Department of Archaeology and Cultural History of the Ancient Mediterranean, University of Hamburg
3. The organiser is represented by the organizing committee. Members of the committee:
  - Dr hab. Artur Obłuski – Director of the Polish Centre of Mediterranean Archaeology
  - Prof. Ewdoksia Papuci-Władyka – Director of the PCMA Research Centre in Cyprus
  - Dr Paweł Lech – Director of the AuAR 2023 International Summer School
4. The team's main tasks include:
  - a) organisational and content preparation for the ISS,
  - b) developing the ISS rules and regulations,
  - c) carrying out the recruitment process for participants in the ISS,
  - d) recruiting lecturers and developing the ISS programme,
  - e) building and maintaining the ISS website,
  - f) development of ISS materials,
  - g) contact with the ISS lecturers, booking airline tickets and hotels for lecturers,
  - h) running the ISS office,
  - i) ensuring that the ISS runs following its programme,
  - j) completion of the ISS work, issuance of relevant certificates,
  - k) evaluation of the ISS,
  - l) preparation of the ISS substantive report and financial settlement.
5. A participant in the AuAr 2023 may be:





- a) a doctoral candidate with doctoral status for the full duration of the School;
- b) an academic employee who obtained a doctoral degree no earlier than 7 years before the date of publication of the AuAr 2023 available chairs.

6. Participation in ISS AuAr 2023 is free.

a) The school is to be implemented for a period of 14 days, between 8.09.2023 - 21.09.2023. In Nea Paphos – Cyprus, in the PCMA Research Centre in Cyprus

- 7. The maximum number of participants in the AuAr 2023 is 15, half of whom should be participants who work or study at a foreign university.
- 8. Within the AuAr 2023, the participation of doctoral candidates and academic employees from the University of Warsaw should not exceed 1/3 of the total number of participants.

## RECRUITMENT RULES

### § 2

- 1. Recruitment to the AuAr 2023 will start at 10:00 on 05.06.2023 and end at 23:59 on 18.06.2023.
- 2. Persons interested in participating in the AuAr 2023 must complete and submit the registration form made available at <https://pcma.uw.edu.pl/en/2023/05/31/cyprus-auar-2023/> by the deadline indicated in paragraph § 2.1.
- 3. In the registration form, the candidate provides his/her personal and contact details and affiliation, includes a cover letter, and agrees to the Organiser's processing of personal data.
- 4. Submission of the registration form by the candidate is only possible after acceptance of these rules.
- 5. The Organising Team carries out the assessment of applications.
- 6. The Organising Team carries out its assessment based on the content of the cover letter.
- 7. The result of the recruitment is approved by the Organising Team. There is no right of appeal against the results.
- 8. Candidates will be notified of the results of their recruitment to the AuAr 2023 via email, by 03.07.2023.



9. If the quota of places is not filled, the Organiser will conduct an additional call from 10.07.2023 to 23.07.2023.
10. Candidates will be notified of the results of the additional recruitment to the School by 24.07.2023.
11. A participant of the AuAr 2023 is obliged to sign the declaration of arrival. In the event of non-signing of the declaration, the Organising Committee may invalidate the decision to qualify for the AuAr 2023. The vacated place is taken by the next person from the reserve list, chosen so as not to affect the proportions specified in § 1, para. 7-9.

## RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE ORGANISER

### § 3

1. The Organiser reserves the right to process personal data following the terms set out in the information clause included in the recruitment form.
2. In justified cases, The Organiser reserves the right to change the dates (daily and hourly) for the implementation of the AuAr 2023.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to decide to change the date of the AuAr 2023, at any time before the commencement of the AuAr 2023, if an epidemic situation or other restrictions on the functions of the University of Warsaw imposed by the Rector of the University of Warsaw so require. The School should, however, take place no later than 30 September 2023. The Organiser will immediately inform candidates or participants in the AuAr 2023 of its decision.
4. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the School or to reduce the number of participants proportionately, while observing the percentage principles in the selection of candidates, as in § 1.9 and § 1.10 and § 1.11, if the results of the recruitment are not satisfactory (not enough applications received).
5. The Organiser is obliged to organise and provide:
  - a) implementation of activities following the School's programme;
  - b) expert staff with the professional competence to teach the School's programme;
  - c) support in finding accommodation for participants in the AuAr 2023;
  - d) issuing participants with a certificate for completing the School.



## RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTICIPANT

### § 4

1. A participant is entitled to:

- a) participation in the lectures, seminars, labs, workshops, field workshops and trips provided for in the AuAr 2023 programme;
- b) individual consultations with expert staff concerning the research project of a participant in the AuAr 2023;
- c) receive conference materials;
- d) use of facilities provided by the Organiser during the AuAr 2023;
- e) to communicate with the Organiser on matters related to the AuAr 2023 at the following email address: [p.lech@uw.edu.pl](mailto:p.lech@uw.edu.pl) or in person, with those persons designated as members of the organising team during the School.

2. The participant undertakes to:

- a) comply with the AuAr 2023 rules and regulations;
- b) participation in the AuAr 2023 activities as evidenced by signatures on attendance registers.

## FEES

### § 5

1. The AuAr 2023 is a project funded by the University of Warsaw (IDUB Programme) and is free of conference fees.

## FINAL PROVISIONS

### § 6

1. The Organiser stipulates that in the event of circumstances beyond its control, e.g., related to the increased danger of an epidemic and related restrictions to the operation of the institution, all classes may be conducted using distance learning methods and techniques. Any information about such changes will be provided by email to the AuAr 2023 participant's address, to which the participant agrees by accepting the AuAr 2023 rules.
2. The rules shall enter into force on the date of their promulgation.
