Dear Colleagues,

I am honored to invite you to submit your papers to the first volume of UNPS - Upper Nile Pottery Studies, which constitutes the proceedings of the Upper Egyptian Pottery Workshop. Connectivity and Cultural Influence held on 14 December 2023 in Warsaw. The publication will appear as a thematic volume of the journal Polish Archaeology in the Mediterranean (PAM) published by University of Warsaw Press, to appear in 2025.

The volume will focus on pottery in the Thebaid, the Eastern and Western Deserts, and the frontier zone between Upper Egypt and Lower Nubia from the Hellenistic to the Early Islamic period (from the 3rd century BC to the 10th century AD).


We welcome papers in the following subject areas:

- Pottery studies on ceramic assemblages from Upper Egyptian and Lower Nubian sites or settlements maintaining intensive connections with this region from the 3rd century BC to the 10th century AD.
- Fresh methodological approaches focusing on new methods and concepts concerning studies on ancient pottery from Upper Egypt and Lower Nubia.
- Petrographic studies of Upper Egyptian and Lower Nubian pottery.
- Economic and consumption studies, examining connectivity between surrounding regions through pottery exchange.
- Reports on new kiln sites and studies on local pottery production.

The deadline for submitting papers is 13 December 2024.

Texts must not exceed 8000 words (including references and figure captions) and must adhere to the guidelines available in the Instructions for PAM contributors tab on the journal's website. Only texts in English will be accepted. Manuscripts should be submitted using the editorial portal

available at www.pam-journal.uw.edu.pl. All articles accepted by the editor will go through the double-blind peer-review process.

The *PAM* journal is indexed in the <u>Scopus database</u> and is included in the list of ranked journals published by Ministry of Education and Science, Poland (100 points). All articles are published in <u>open access</u>.
