Part of a floral pectoral painted with exquisite craftsmanship on the cartonnage of a high-ranking nobleman. The painting was varnished. Assuming that the fragments of rectangular wooden coffin discovered in the tomb belonged to the same burial, a date after the Twenty-second Dynasty would be most likely.
